

Protect Yourself and Others

PERSONAL HYGIENE ETIQUETTE

1. All staff will wash their hands with soap/water for 20 seconds after returning from lunch, break or using the restroom, and after every new activity/task.
2. Sanitizers are permitted if soap and water are not readily available. Rub the hand sanitizer for at least 20 seconds.

DO NOT touch your eyes, nose, and mouth even with gloves on

Cover your nose or mouth when you sneeze/cough with a disposable tissue or your arm. Throw the tissue away after using it

Social Distancing

1. It is recommended that any interaction with students or staff be done with keeping a social distance of 6ft. or more between all persons.
2. All unnecessary physical contact is prohibited. This includes hand

OTHER SURFACES

1. Restrooms and all the surfaces should be cleaned and sanitized on a regular schedule with emphasis on "high touched areas "
2. Playground equipment should be sanitized often between groups.
3. Water Fountains should be marked as off limits and not be operable to discourage their use. They should also be kept clean and sanitized.

AIR EXCHANGE

1. It is recommended that a door or window be open, whenever possible to promote good air exchange.
2. Fans and exhaust systems could be used if there are security risks.

Bus Drivers Reporting to Work COVID-19

Getting screened before reporting to work:

- Fever/Chills (over 100 °F)
- Cough (hard to control)
- Fatigue
- Diarrhea
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Loss of taste
- Loss of smell

Sitting Arrangements

Students will be required to wear a mask and avoid blocking the path of others by sitting down quickly, one child per row on opposite sides of the bus.

Use floor decals, colored tape or signs to show where students may sit.

Students will remain sitting until operator instructs them to onboard. Windows should be opened when feasible to promote good air exchange.

Alternatives to Bus Transportation

Parents should consider other alternatives to commuting such as escorting children to school, dropping children off and car pooling in small groups.

Prepare the bus for safety of students

Sanitizing/Disinfecting

Bus driver has to wear mask and gloves at ALL times

Practice routine cleaning and sanitizing of the unit, focus on "cockpit" and other surfaces commonly touched

Sanitize seats, steering wheels, knobs, door handles, hand rails, passenger seats, and windows

Sanitize after each stop, before allowing students to board (each bus trip)

Boarding/Getting off

Operators will monitor students making sure they are 6ft. apart.

Temperature checks are not required.
