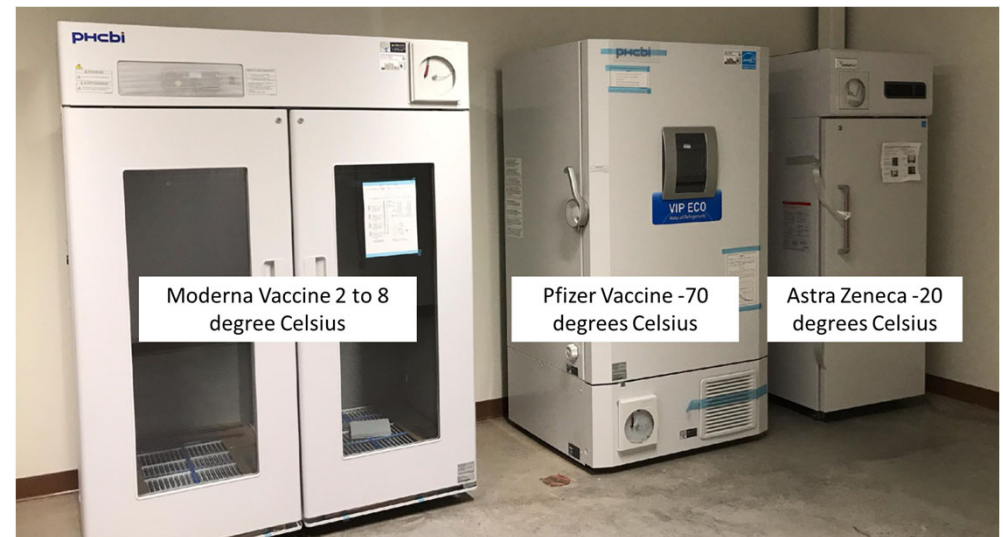

COVID-19 Vaccine Preparation

- Completed registration and approval.
- Purchased necessary equipment:
 - -70 Ultra Cold Freezers (Pfizer)
 - -20 Freezers (Moderna)
 - Increased Refrigeration Capacity (Johnson & Johnson and Astra Zeneca)
- Designated prepositioned site.
- Enhanced security.



COVID-19 Vaccine Arrival

- Dec. 15th: UMC received 2,925 Vaccines.
- First waive of vaccines, per CDC, for front line providers.
- Created a three tiered system for prioritization.
- Extended vaccine to critical community partners:
 - Texas Tech Health Sciences Center Physicians
 - El Paso Children's Hospital Associates and Physicians
 - Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
 - Medical Examiner's Office
- Unclear as to future shipments or allocations.

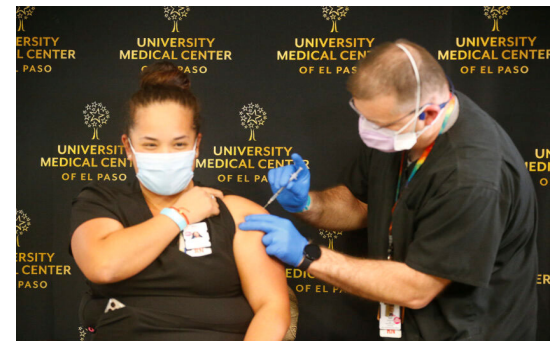

COVID-19 Future Vaccine Distribution Sites

- Neighborhood Health Center East
- Neighborhood Health Center West
- Neighborhood Health Center Ysleta
- Neighborhood Health Center Fabens
- Mobile Medical Unit



COVID-19 Future Distribution Clinics Process

- UMC Vaccine Hotline
 - Implemented a COVID-19 hotline (915) 975-8900
 - COVID-19 vaccine
 - COVID-19 infusion
 - COVID-19 symptoms or questions
- Clinics will begin targeted patient population vaccination
 - As per Texas Department of State Health Services allocation plan
 - Set up a daily provider schedule Monday-Saturday at East and West and Monday thru Friday at Ysleta and Fabens.



COVID-19 Vaccine Additional Distribution Methods

- Per DSHS Vaccine distribution
- Mobile Medical Unit: County of El Paso Partnership w UMC
 - Developing process to administer the vaccine via a drive thru process once allotted by the State.
- County Coliseum (possible drive thru)





UMC Covid -19 Vaccine Communication

- UMC will announce specific times and locations for member of the public
 - UMC Clinics working with patients now to inform and educate on the safety and efficacy of the Vaccine.
 - UMC will notify all local media
 - UMC will utilize radio advertisement in English and Spanish
 - UMC will utilize Social media postings to further information to the public
 - UMC will Partner with Public Health and other community agencies



UMC Covid -19 Vaccine FAQs

- Unaware of subsequent shipments
- For this first shipment, only front line hospital workers are being vaccinated
- Next group will include people at high risk for severe complications and people over age 65
- UMC anticipates public vaccinations to begin in February/March
- UMC is not developing a wait list for vaccination
